Act the undersigned corporation adopts the following Articles of Amendment to its Articles of Incorporation: FIRST: The name of the corporation is Santa Fe Botanical Garden SECOND: The following amendment to the Articles of Incorporation was adopted by the corporation on <u>September 19, 1988</u>, in the manner prescribed by the New Mexico Nonprofit Corporation Act: (INSERT AMENIMENT)
Article Three is to be amended to read as follows: Santa Fe Botanical Garden is oraganized exclusively for educational and charitable purposes within the meaning of 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code under which we will collect and display a wide variety of plant specimens; preserve rare and endangered plants; carry out plant-related research and educate the public throughdisplays, classes and the sales of seeds, books, plants and other horticultural (See Attachment.) materials. (Mark an X by the appropriate action taken): THIRD A quorum of the members entitled to vote was present and the amendment received at least two-thirds (2/3) of the votes which members present at the meeting or represented by proxy were entitled to cast; The amendment was adopted by a consent in writing signed by all members entitled to vote thereto; No members are entitled to vote thereon, therefore, the vote of a majority of the board of directors in office voted for adoption of said

amendment.
